SUBJ: NPS UNMANNED AERIAL SYSTEMS (UAS) TRAINING UPDATE

- 1. Recent policy changes substantively updated Group 1 and 2 UAS training and operations requirements. These changes necessitate updating the minimum training requirements for Aerial Vehicle Operator (AVO) qualification.
- 2. To retain NPS AVO designation, the following directives shall be reviewed in their entirety unless otherwise annotated.
 - a. 14 CFR part 91.113
 - b. SECNAVINST 3700.2
 - c. OPNAVINST 3500.39
 - d. OPNAVINST 3750.6S
 - e. CNAF M-3710.7 (Sections 3.7 through 3.9)
 - f. CNAF M-3710.9
- 3. AVOs shall be familiar with the airspace in which they operate. Prior to flight operations, AVOs will review applicable local airspace procedures. At a minimum, AVOs shall review Federal Aviation Administration Certificate of Authorization (FAA COA) or rules governing U.S. special use airspace (ie: military operating areas, warning areas, or restricted areas) for the areas they intend to conduct operations.
- 4. NPSINST 3700.1B and NPSINST 3750.1 remain in effect until superseded. In the event there is a conflict between local policy and published policy from higher authority, the more restrictive policy shall prevail. Report any disparities for resolution and clarification; no policy is a replacement for sound judgement.
- 5. NPS UAS AVOs shall report completion of the above training update by returning an electronically signed endorsement below to the NPS Air Operations Officer.
