ACCESS TO NAVAL POSTGRADUATE SCHOOL

US CITIZENS

All US citizens who register for the symposium will be placed on the Naval Postgraduate School access list for Thursday, May 26, 2016 so that you may attend the post-symposium NPS tour and CRUSER Tech Expo. Since entry requires your name to be on the access list, it will be necessary to register at least one week prior to the symposium. Although it is possible to register on site, this will potentially delay your entry to NPS while we obtain approval for access.

You are strongly encouraged to register prior to arrival.

OFFICIAL INTERNATIONAL VISITORS

Foreign attendees who attend the symposium as representatives of their government, and who plan to participate in the post-symposium event at the Naval Postgraduate School, will be considered *Official Visitors*. Official visits to the Naval Postgraduate School, by Foreign National Visitors, must be approved through the Navy International Programs Office. The visitor should contact the Defense Attache at their Embassy in Washington and ask that they submit a request to visit the Naval Postgraduate School. Advise the defense attache's office to reference "*The Guide to Foreign Attaches Accredited to the Department of the Navy*". Procedures for submissions of visit requests to the Naval Postgraduate School are included in that manual.

To ensure timely visit request approval, you should submit your visit request to your defense attache's office no later than 1 month prior to the start of the event. To verify visit approval by the Naval Postgraduate School, send your inquiry to your Embassy approximately two weeks after original submission of your visit request to your defense attache's office.

Your request to the Defense Attache's offices should indicate "To attend the 13th International Mine Warfare Symposium" post-symposium events as the purpose of the visit. The points of contact (POC's) at the Naval Postgraduate School are:
