

# Brief Introduction

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The objective for developing the MoPH HMIS Provincial Profile is to provide a synopsis of provincial health sector performance for health sector decision makers, provincial teams, program managers and health workers to make evidenced based decisions which will improve the health outcomes of the population. This information allows provincial teams to analyze the performance of all provinces. It is anticipated that provincial teams will use this information to understand better what is working in the health sector and to strengthen provincial relationships to synergize efforts to improve health programs and build upon the successes to continue to improve population health outcomes.

There are four components to guide provincial analysis and discussion:

1. A Provincial Overview detailing the current health status of the population
2. The BPHS contractors implementing health services by province
3. The health facility history
4. Indicator trends from multiple data sources including HMIS. Survey results which can only be disaggregated at provincial level have been used. These sources include:
  - National Risk and Vulnerability Assessment (NRVA) 2007-08
  - National Health Services Performance Assessment (BSC) 2010/2011
  - Health Management Information System Data Base
  - HMIS Health Facility History database
  - GCMU grant database
  - HMIS Geographic Information System

It is anticipated that a development plan to address poorer health outcomes will be developed at the health sector stakeholder committees including the PHCC and the BPHS and EPHS coordination committees.
